Donations to date are **529** pounds! Many of this month's donations came from David Kelly's kitchen. If we give 100 pounds each month, we can meet our goal. Check your cupboard/pantry for items, scan store sales, or the discount produce. Please remember that perishable items must be delivered between 10am-1pm M-F to the Food Bank. Please continue to bring unperishable items to the barrel in the foyer closet, and the Deacons will see that they are delivered. Your generosity makes a difference.
